30 points

- Labyrinth:** Research the mythical King Minos and the Minotaur, create a labyrinth that reflects the details in the story.
- Create your own **city-state** - be sure to include: government, name, culture, legacy...
- Presentation (or Video)** - Recite the Pericles *Funeral Oration* - a classic speech of what Athenians believed in. Pretend as if you were Pericles giving the speech
- Create a model** of famous architecture from Ancient Greece (statue of Zeus, Parthenon, etc)
- Give a **powerpoint presentation** on an Ancient Greek topic of your choice
- Create a **children's book** that tells the story a famous Greek legend or myth
- Make a Deck of Playing Cards** - each card should explain a different god, goddess, hero, etc...
- Build a Model of a **Trojan Horse**
- Build a **Diorama or model** of one of the epic battles (Marathon or Peloponnesian War)
- Research ancient **foods**, share a **meal**, and give a **presentation** about Greek foods
- Create an **iMovie** on a topic of your choice in this Unit
- Write your own **song lyrics** and record them (CD or Music Video)
- Create a **Board Game of Trivia** from the Ancient Greece Unit

20 points

- Research paper** - research any aspect of of Ancient Greek culture (architecture, mythology, culture, etc...) and write a 5 paragraph research paper that explains three things you learned.
- Create a **powerpoint presentation** on an Ancient Greek topic of your choice
- Write an **original myth** (using Greek myths as a model) that explains a natural event (snow, storms, rain, sun, sunsets, etc...)
- Make an **Infographic** of an Ancient Greek topic of your choice
- Write a brief **Biography** of a **famous Greek figure** (Alexander the Great, Pericles, Aristotle, etc...)
- Make a **poster/trifold** that explains the **ancient greek olympics** and explain how they inspired the olympics of today.
- Write your own **song Lyrics** (30 points if you perform the song!)
- Create a **4-scene Comic Strip** on your Topic
- Create a **cereal box** of a leader

10 points

- Create a **Crossword/Wordsearch** with all the vocabulary terms from Chapter 6
- Learn the Greek **Alphabet** - Create a poster that shows the letters and how they are written
- Make a **"tourist pamphlet"** for important places to visit in ancient Greece
- Draw a **Map** of Ancient Greece
- Create an **Acrostic Poem** about a topic of your choice in this Unit
